Fall Baseball & Fastpitch Clinic October 5

Former Chicago Cub along with baseball and fastpitch standouts from around the state to coach clinic; register today

Former Chicago Cubs pitcher, Justin Berg, along with baseball and fastpitch standouts from throughout the state, will be gathering in Weston, WI on Saturday, October 5 for the inaugural Fall Baseball & Fastpitch Clinic. Presented by The Premier Sports Academy (The Academy), with sponsorship from Stevens Point Orthopedics, the purpose of the clinic is to provide players with drills they can practice, over the next few months, to improve their technique before the winter training season kicks off in December.

Greening says he is excited for the clinic to debut because, "The thing we have always centered on was to be able to bring high-level opportunities to baseball and fastpitch players in central Wisconsin. This clinic, in keeping with that theme, will include some of the best coaching talent to ever come to the area in a single day. Not only are we bringing in outside talent to help the youth develop as players, we are also using our local, in-house talent to provide this high level training not only on October 5, but year round."



Along with preparing for the off-season and participating in live game play with situational coaching, athletes in both sections will observe demonstrations of the Noraxon 3D Motion Analysis System from Sheila Banovetz, MS, PT, of Stevens Point Orthopedics. Noraxon is the most advanced 3D motion analysis technology available in the area and allows athletes to reach new levels of performance while minimizing the risk of injury. Sixteen sensors capture an athlete's motion, while eight additional sensors monitor muscle strength. The system measures and records the exact response an athlete's muscles have to every action they perform—throwing, batting, pitching—and can be utilized to address areas of improvement.

In addition to Berg, standout baseball and fastpitch athletes Whitney Tornow (UWGB/UWO), Scott Greening (St. Scholastica), Stacey Marcum (MN-Crookston), Mike Aiello (St. Paul Saints), John Roberts (Wayne State) and Eric Greening (UW-Whitewater) will all be in attendance. "I'm very excited to not only meet new athletes, but hope to utilize my knowledge of the game and skill set to help them grow and love the game" Tornow shares in anticipation of this unique coaching opportunity.

The sessions will be held at The Academy, located at 8706 Progress Way in Weston, Wisconsin. Open to students from any school or district, athletes will have an opportunity to learn drills they can practice on their own, over the next few months, in anticipation for the winter training season.
